### Course Objective:

Students will be able to speak, comprehend, read, and write intermediate-level Korean sentences. In addition, they will learn fundamentals of Korean Culture through interactive class room activities and homework assignments.

### Course Policies:

#### 1. Class attendance

- If you cannot attend class due to sickness, please notify me in advance if possible and submit a doctor's note when you come back to class.
- Form the 6th unexcused absence, your final grade will be reduced one grade for each additional unexcused absence. #### 2. Quizzes and Tests

- In each lesson, there will be a vocabulary quiz, an oral quiz and a test. There are **no make-up quizzes or tests under any circumstances**; however, the lowest quiz and test scores will be dropped.

- If you turn in homework assignment one day late, you will get maximum 7.5 points out of 15. Homework older than two days is not accepted.
