

## **KREN 4002: Business Korean II (Spring 2007)**

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### **Course Objectives: Continuation of KREN 4001**

This course will focus on building an advanced-level reading, vocabulary, and grammar knowledge in Korean for a variety of verbal and written communications. Students will be familiar with Korean business culture through classroom activities and homework assignments based on authentic material. Topics will include formal communication skills, basic Chinese characters frequently used in formal writing, and current issues related to Korean economy, society, and culture.

**Textbook:** Ho-min Sohn & Eun-joo Lee, *Integrated Korean Advanced Intermediate 2* (Honolulu: U of Hawaii P, 2003).

### **Requirements:**

1. Homework assignments: 20 points
2. Bi-weekly Chapter exams: 50 points
3. Final exam: 20 points
6. Presentation: 10 points

### **Grading and Course Policy:**

2. Attendance & Participation: students are expected to attend all classes. If you have more than 5 unexcused absences, you will lose 2 points of your final numerical grade each additional time you miss a class.
