

2018 Summer Korean Internship Application

The Korean language program at the University of Georgia provides UGA students with an opportunity to work as interns in a Korean high school during the summer of 2018. It is a one-month unpaid internship with free board and lodging. Information about applying for the 2018 internship is shown below.

- English teaching, administrative work, leading extracurricular activities, etc.

- Application close: 12.13.2017

Application Process

An applicant must submit an application form to **KoreanUGA@uga.edu**. The application form will be available for download on the comparative literature website (http://www.cmlt.uga.edu). <u>Please note</u> <u>that only typed application is accepted</u>. Selected applicants must make a deposit of \$200. The deposit will cover expenses for domestic trips organized by the schools. With regard to details of the deposit, there will be further notice.

* Participants are responsible for their own airfare and other travel expenses. They may be supported by external financial resources such as the UGA Freeman-ASIA Scholarship (http://www.iie.org/programs/freeman-asia) and OIE Asia-Georgia Internship Connection Scholarship (https://goabroad.uga.edu/index.cfm?FuseAction=Programs.ListAll&type=3).

* In the selection process, priority will be given to those students who have declared or are considering pursuing a Korean major or minor.
